First Steps Puppy Socialization Classes This class is for puppies between the ages of 9 weeks and 17 weeks of age. Basic commands (sit, down and come) are taught. Puppies are allowed play time with each other for socialization. Common puppy problems are discussed during the class (chewing, housebreaking, and jumping). This is a fun class to help you and your puppy begin the training process. Only positive reinforcement is used. Bring yummy treats and your puppy leash to first class.

On Track Family Dog Training :

This class is for dogs over 18 weeks of age. A copy of “Family Friendly Dog Training” book written by Patricia McConnell is given to every member of this class. The class follows the 6 week program of positive reinforcement to teach basic commands. Basic obedience skills are covered(heel, sit, stay, down and come) as well as many other useful techniques. This class will help get you started in your training. Bring yummy treats and your pet on a leash to first class.
