- ABOUT US -

At Animal Tracks Veterinary Service we strive to nurture a healthy bond between our clients and their furry children! We understand that part of that bond is ensuring the safety, health, and happiness of your dog while you are away! We incorporate play time, enrichment, brushing, and quiet time into our Daycare routine for a well-rounded daily experience. We join in on the fun ourselves, loving each furry kid as if they were our own! Your pet should feel right at home with all of the affection, attention, playtime, and love they'll be receiving!

With our large indoor play area, and recently expanded outdoor space your pet will have plenty of room to play! Always included is ample access to fresh, clean drinking water, quiet nap time over the lunch hour, and a comfortable environment with a temperature controlled play room! Our outdoor play space includes ample shade, pool time, plenty of toys, and space to run! Our goal is to allow dogs to have the chance to do what they do best...love life unconditionally!

- REQUIREMENTS -

To ensure the safety of our guests and playtime friends, we require all dogs staying with us for Daycare or Boarding meet the following criteria:

🐾 Dogs must first undergo a hands-on assessment with our Kennel Attendant team prior to attending Daycare

🐾 Dogs must be at minimum, 3 months old

🐾 Dogs must be spayed or neutered if six months or older

🐾 Current on the following vaccines:
Rabies Distemper Bordetella

Proof of current vaccinations is required prior to your dog's assessment and any future play time!

🐾 Current on a **vet-approved** flea & tick preventative
So we can assure our playtime friends do not bring in or pick up fleas while at our facility. Fleas can live on a pet year round! If you are unsure that your current prevention program meets the requirements please ask an Animal Tracks team member.

🐾 Have a current negative intestinal (fecal) exam or a vet-approved all-inclusive dewormer every 6 months
Most internal parasites, or worms, are shed in the feces in the form of eggs. These can only be seen under the microscope and can be found in even the most normal looking stool. To stop your pet and other furry guests from being exposed to these parasites we require all daycare & boarding pets to be screened for parasites!

Meeting the above requirements allows for each and every dog to have a fun and positive experience when they come to play!

- BENEFITS -

Exercise

Exercise for your pet while playing with their friends, leading to tired pets ready to snuggle and nap at home!

Behavior

Doggie Daycare can help to alleviate boredom, and loneliness that cause destructive behaviors and separation anxiety at home! Though playtime is not an answer to all behaviors, it can certainly help those restless and ready to play pups!

Socialization

Playtime with EVERYONE gives your pet the chance to socialize with dogs of all breeds, ages, sizes, and temperaments. This creates a well-rounded socialization experience for your pet!

Supervised Play-time

You, as a pet owner, may not always feel comfortable to recognize good and bad behaviors during playtime, or have other furry friends for you pet to play with.

At Doggie Daycare we have supervision by staff prepared to interpret dog behaviors, social cues, and body language at all times and intervene as necessary.

Human Lovin'!

No more guilt of leaving your pet at home while you work or run errands! Staff at Animal Tracks Veterinary Service is very well trained in offering love, hugs, ear scratches, and belly rubs!



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- A S S E S S M E N T -

A Doggie Daycare Assessment is the first step in a fun, social playtime experience that will have your pet bursting through our doors eager to play! At Animal Tracks Veterinary Service, the safety of all dogs in our care is very important to us. A proper Doggie Daycare Assessment will ensure your pet is a great fit for our open play environment, and our daycare a great fit for them! We want your dog to properly experience all the benefits that daycare has to offer!

Assessments are scheduled similar to appointments!
Please call ahead to schedule an assessment time.

For your pet's assessment, please arrive with your dog on a leash both in the parking lot and clinic. Our team of receptionists will greet you upon entry into the lobby! A Kennel Attendant or other team member will meet with you to begin our Doggie Daycare Assessment.

An Assessment begins with an overview of your completed Doggie Daycare Application, and the history and health of your pet. Your pet will then follow our team member to the Daycare room where we will first conduct a snout-to-tail assessment; this allows us to identify any areas of sensitivity your pet may have. It is important to us that we identify this early on for the comfort of your pet while in our care! We ask that pet parents stay in our front lobby for the duration of the assessment so we can get a true sense of your pet's response to us, and fellow dogs! During this time we are also interpreting your pet's reaction when away from their parent. Beginning with an empty playroom and the use of leashes allows us to create a controlled mini play area for us to assess your dog's comfort level. A few additional dogs will be brought into the Daycare room one at a time. Our team members will observe your dog's reaction to other pets as they approach, and the response of other pet's as well by looking for various behavioral cues, and interpreting their body language.

Our team member will then share what they learned with you! Do we only turn away dogs who show aggressive behaviors? Absolutely not! Red flags during an assessment can also come from dogs who are timid or have not experienced a great deal of socialization. Our biggest goal in Doggie Daycare is happy, healthy dogs who enjoy playing and friends! Dogs who are extremely nervous, fearful, and anxious are not suitable for Daycare. If a dog is not yet ready for our open play environment we will recommend steps the parent can take to address any concerns. We can always set up another assessment at a future date!

Dogs who have been approved are welcome to stay and play after their assessment. Our team member will discuss how to proceed in regards to bringing your pet to Daycare, payment, and pick-up!
